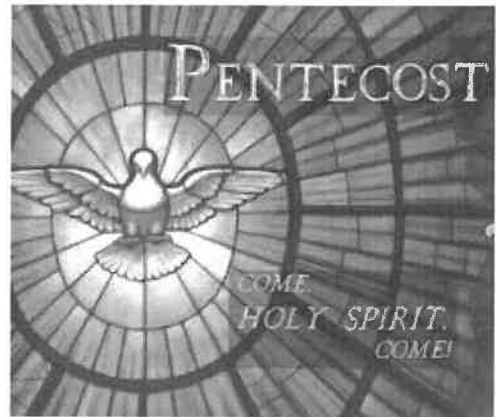
PENTECOST NOVENA

The Pentecost Novena is the first of the Church's novenas.

After Jesus' Ascension into heaven,
His disciples came together in the upper room
to devote themselves to constant prayer (Acts 1:14).

They prayed for nine days
before receiving the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Pentecost Sunday this year is on June 9, 2019



On May 4, 1897, Pope Leo XIII proclaimed: "We decree and command that throughout the whole Church, this year and in every subsequent year, a novena shall take place before Pentecost in all parish churches." Pope John Paul II reiterated Pope Leo's command for a worldwide Pentecost novena, although the novena can be prayed at any time — not only before Pentecost.

Try to go to Mass daily throughout the novena and pray for the outpouring of the Spirit. If you are unable to attend Mass, read and reflect upon the daily readings. The following prayers are suggested.

Pray: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful,
and enkindle in them the fire of Your love.
Send forth Your Spirit, and they shall be created,
and You shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray.
O God, Who by the light of the Holy Spirit,
did instruct the hearts of Your faithful,
grant that by that same Holy Spirit,
we may be truly wise
and ever rejoice in His consolation,
through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Read: The daily Mass readings for May 31st - June 8th, 2019.

Pray: Loving God,
renew in our hearts the seven-fold gifts of Your Spirit:
wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge,
piety, and wonder and awe;

that our lives might bear an abundant harvest of the fruits of your spirit:
love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness,
faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
